Dear Greenwood Township Property Owners: To better serve you, The Fire Department would like to remind you that it is your responsibility to clear snow and debris from your drive and entrance ways. Your street address must be clearly visible from the roadway. If you do not have your address sign, they can be obtained through the Oscoda Sheriff Department at 989-826-3214.

The Greenwood Township offices are open: Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.

If you need zoning permits, see the Zoning Administrator, Monday, Wednesday and Fridays from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm.

The Township Assessor is available in the township office each Wednesday from 10:00 am to 2:00pm.

Starting January 1, 2010, we will be charging 50 cents per visit for recycling. Bring as much as you like per visit. This is to offset some of the cost to keep recycling in the township.

Our 2010 free "dump" day will be held on June 26th. We will take most anything **Except:** Tires, appliances with freon gas in them, (such as refrigerators, and Air conditioners), or engines with gas or oil in them.

Look for flyers in May of 2010 for our Highway and Byways cleanup day

The nature trail and park project is now completed. This 4 year project was accomplished with grants, cash donations, material and labor donations. The cost to the township was about \$8,000.00. Residents are encouraged to use the new facilities. There are no reservations and no rental charges. It belongs to you.

Great News: The Greenwood Township Offices and The Fire Department building will be paid off in May 2010. This means a drop in your property tax next year.....however

Bad News: We have two 25 year old fire trucks (tankers) and we need to replace one immediately. We will be asking the taxpayers for a millage increase next year. A new tanker is about \$300,000.00.
